There is a \$10/week or \$5/day, non-refundable/non-transferable deposit due with completed forms before your child is enrolled in summer camp. This deposit is applied to the weekly fee. The remainder of the registration fees will be due the Thursday before the week of camp your child is enrolled.

There is a 10% discount off full price for additional children per household.

Our Staff and Program

We believe the quality of our program is due to our amazing staff. Our camp counselors are fun, talented college students or graduates with extensive experience working with school aged children. Our camp counselor to student ratio is 1:15. All counselors are trained in CPR, First Aid, AED, Positive Behavior Management and Vehicle Safety. Our enthusiastic staff serve as activity leaders and mini-bus drivers, meeting state guidelines.

Each week at camp will include different expanded STEAM programming such as archery, cooking, outdoor education, science and technology projects; biking, hiking, fishing, martial arts, pottery, dance; and local history, arts, and nature field trips!

On or before 5pm Thursday the week before camp	Full refund less \$10/week or \$5/day deposit. Cancellation must be made for exact schedule chosen. Cancellations must be made in writing/email. We can accept switches for other days or weeks if room is available.
After Thursday the week before camp	No refunds or changes available. Full payment due for all registered days. This is to ensure the quality of program supplies and staffing.
